Looking to the future of Cedar Springs Public Schools, the Board of Education is asking the community to vote on a school bond proposal on the November 5, 2019 election ballot. If the bond proposal is approved by voters, it would provide \$81,150,000 for district-wide improvements.

Improvements at Beach Elementary School would include:

LEARNING ENVIRONMENTS

- Demolishing the existing 1960s academic wings
- Constructing new, modern classrooms to support 21st century learning and student population growth
- New classroom furniture and equipment
- Upgrading educational technology and classroom multimedia, as needed
- New media center

BUILDING AND SITE IMPROVEMENTS

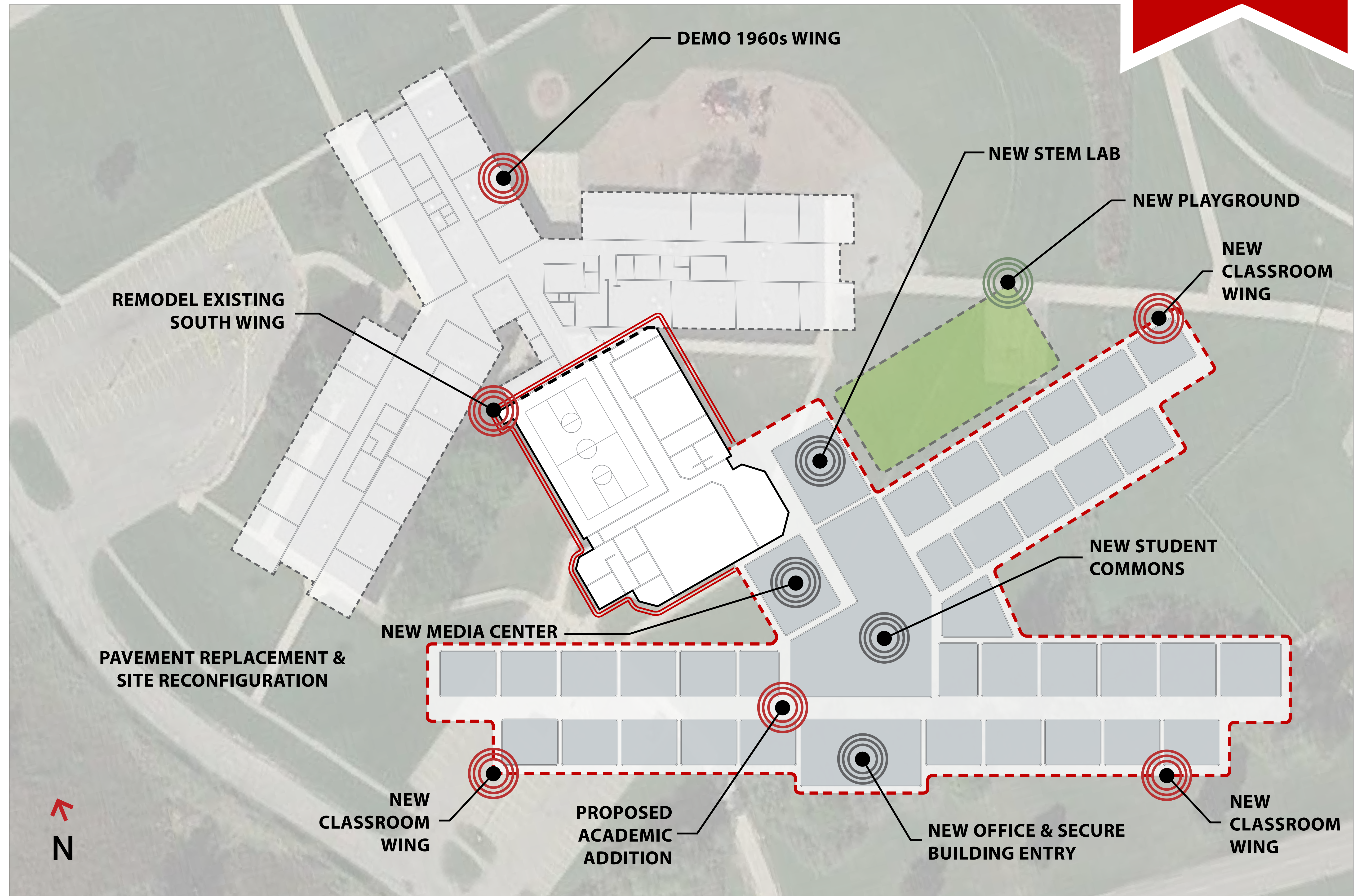
- Minor remodeling of existing 1990s construction
- Replacing selective pavement

SAFETY AND SECURITY

- Reconfiguration of existing drives to improve traffic flow, pick-up and drop-off
- Improving playground and play spaces
- New office with secure building entry
