Looking to the future of Cedar Springs Public Schools, the Board of Education is asking the community to vote on a school bond proposal on the November 5, 2019 election ballot. If the bond proposal is approved by voters, it would provide \$81,150,000 for district-wide improvements.

Improvements at Cedar Trails Elementary School would include:

### LEARNING ENVIRONMENTS

- Relocating preschool and early childhood programming to Red Hawk would provide additional space for current Kindergarten and 1st grade students and allow for future student population growth
- Upgrading educational technology and classroom multimedia, as needed

### BUILDING AND SITE IMPROVEMENTS

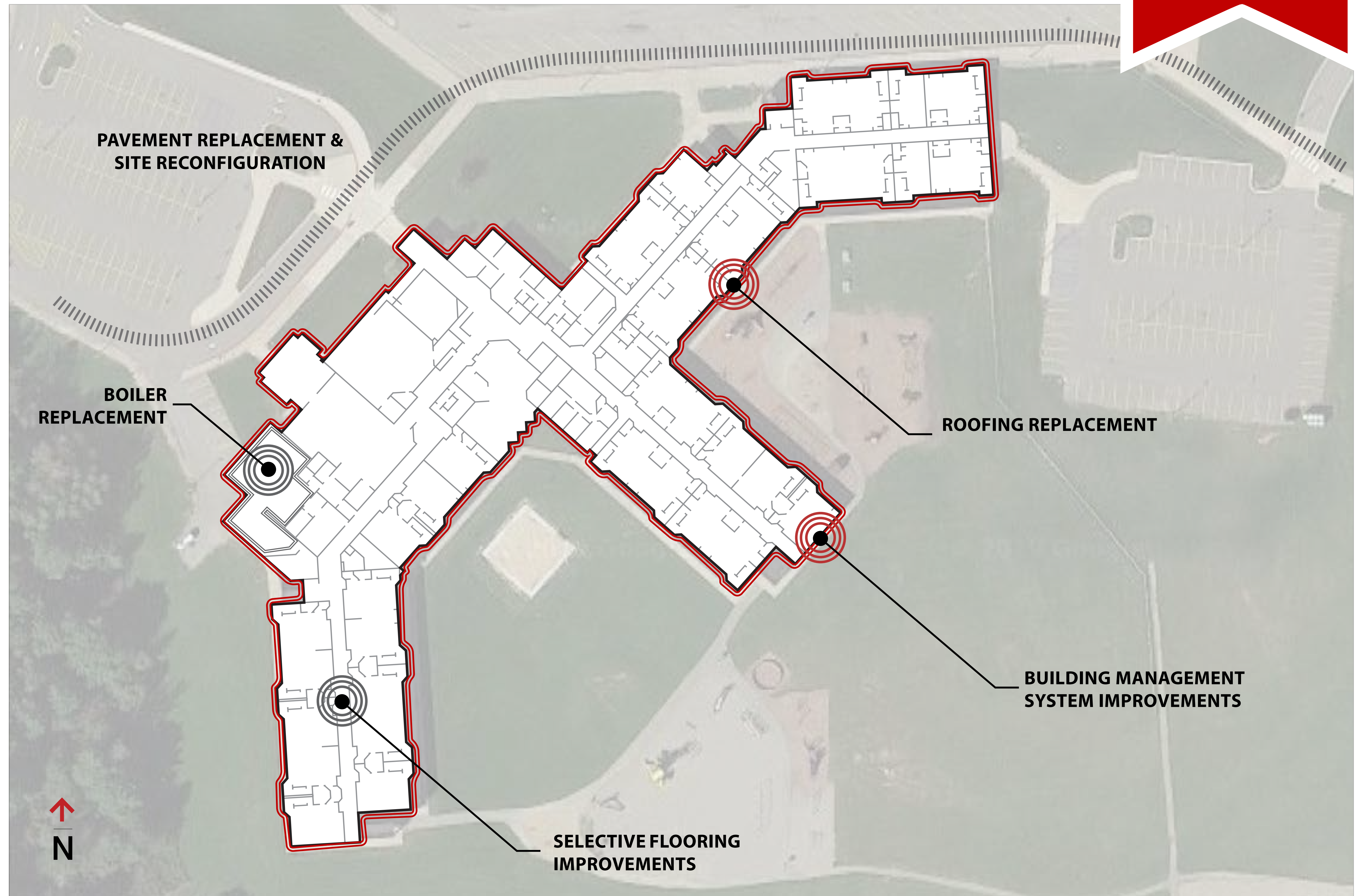
- Replacing selective classroom and corridor flooring
- Replacing selective roofing
- Replacing boilers
- Upgrading building management systems for energy efficiency
- Replacing selective pavement

### SAFETY AND SECURITY

- Improving playground and play spaces
- Reconfiguration of existing drives to improve traffic flow, pick up and drop off
