Looking to the future of Cedar Springs Public Schools, the Board of Education is asking the community to vote on a school bond proposal on the November 5, 2019 election ballot. If the bond proposal is approved by voters, it would provide \$81,150,000 for district-wide improvements.

Improvements at Cedar Springs High School would include:

LEARNING ENVIRONMENTS

- Removing ninth grade students to alleviate capacity issues at the High School. Ninth grade students would be relocated to the proposed eighth-ninth grade school, once constructed.
- New classroom furniture and equipment, as needed
- Upgrading educational technology and classroom multimedia, as needed.

BUILDING AND SITE IMPROVEMENTS

- Upgrading mechanical systems, including replacing boiler and chiller
- Replacing flooring, as necessary
- Replacing selective roofing
- Upgrading building management systems for energy efficiency
