Looking to the future of Cedar Springs Public Schools, the Board of Education is asking the community to vote on a school bond proposal on the November 5, 2019 election ballot. If the bond proposal is approved by voters, it would provide \$81,150,000 for district-wide improvements.

Improvements at Cedar Springs Middle School would realign this building from seventh-eighth grade to sixth-seventh grade, as well as:

### LEARNING ENVIRONMENTS

- Eighth grade students would be re-located to the proposed eighth-ninth grade school, once constructed
- Upgrading educational technology and classroom multimedia, as needed

### BUILDING AND SITE IMPROVEMENTS

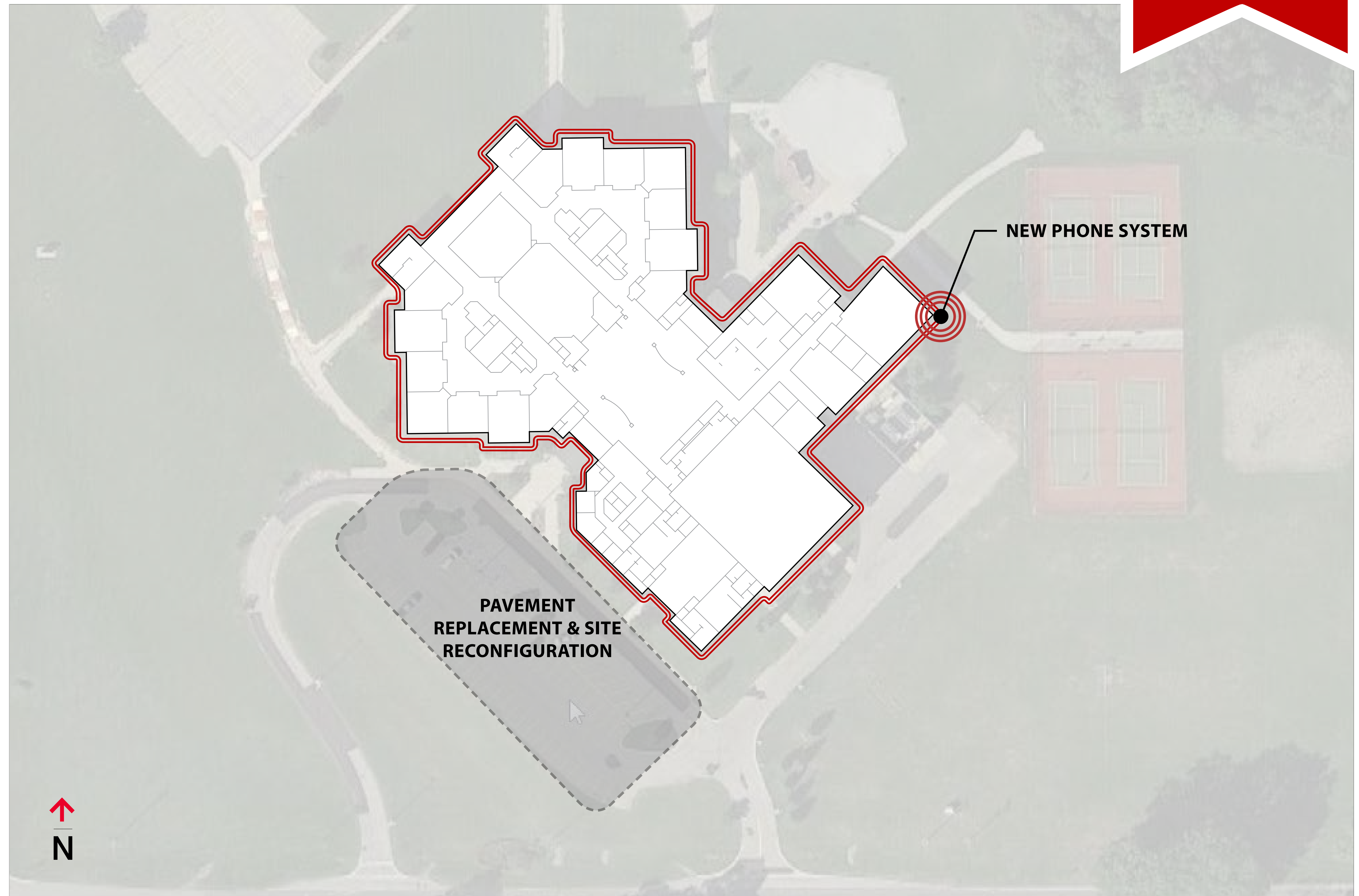
- Replacing selective pavement

### SAFETY AND SECURITY

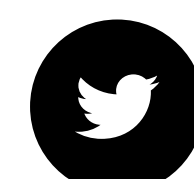
- Reconfiguration of existing drives to improve traffic flow, pick up and drop off
