Looking to the future of Cedar Springs Public Schools, the Board of Education is asking the community to vote on a school bond proposal on the November 5, 2019 election ballot. If the bond proposal is approved by voters, it would provide \$81,150,000 for district-wide improvements.

Improvements would include:

LEARNING ENVIRONMENTS

- Constructing a new eighth-ninth grade building
 - Alleviating capacity issues at the High School
 - Providing an age-appropriate transition from the Middle School to the High School
 - Locating the proposed building adjacent to the High School to support educational programming opportunities
- Building features would include
 - Capacity for 500-750 students
 - Student devices and classroom multimedia
 - New furniture
 - Multi-purpose cafeteria
 - Media Center with commons area for large group instruction
 - Auxiliary gym to support district and community activities
