Looking to the future of Cedar Springs Public Schools, the Board of Education is asking the community to vote on a school bond proposal on the November 5, 2019 election ballot. If the bond proposal is approved by voters, it would provide \$81,150,000 for district-wide improvements.

Improvements at Red Hawk would transform the existing sixth grade building to Community Education, Early Childhood Education and District Administration, including:

LEARNING ENVIRONMENTS

- Improving classrooms to create age appropriate learning environments for the Early Childhood
- New classroom furniture and equipment
- Indoor air quality would be improved by the replacement of classroom unit ventilators
- Upgrading educational technology and classroom multimedia, as needed

BUILDING AND SITE IMPROVEMENTS

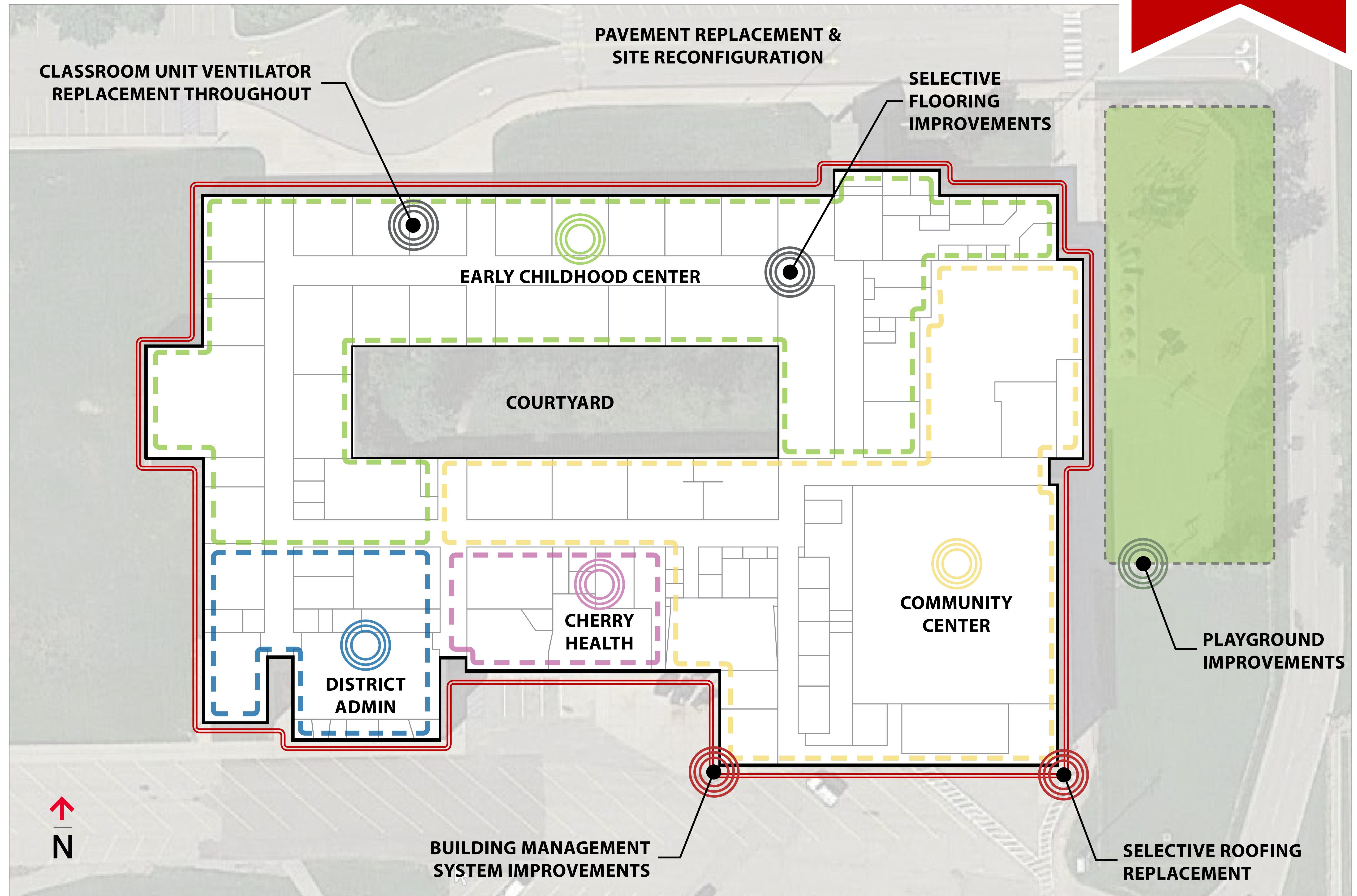
- Improving playground and play spaces
- Replacing flooring and casework, as necessary
- Updating mechanical systems
- Upgrading building management systems for energy efficiency
- Replacing roofing
- Relocating District computer servers
- Replacing selective pavement

SAFETY AND SECURITY

- Reconfiguration of existing drives to improve traffic flow, pick up and drop off

- Renovations in 1960, 1968, 1970, 1975, 2018
