



RHO Update: Sept 4

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Graduation Enrollments

- As I'm sure everyone knows through your email notifications, enrollments were completed this past week.
- Most students should see their first 2 courses listed in Grad Alliance
- The pacing default in Graduate Alliance is set at 6 weeks per 2 classes

CSPS Teacher Consultants

- Each RHO student is assigned a CSPS teacher as a consultant. CSPS teachers are not teaching the courses but are in place to support students, answer questions, and help with pacing.
- Each teacher-consultant will be reaching out week 1, so be sure to watch your email. They will be asking for the best means to connect with students as well (phone, email, text, etc.)

RHO Weekly Expectations

- Every RHO student MUST have at least 2 documented, two-way communications with their teacher-consultant each week
 - Communication can be phone, zoom, email, or text.
 - Communication must talk about your progress in each course since the last communication and or specific, course-specific questions you may have.
- Each student MUST complete at least one assignment each week in each enrolled course. Keep in mind this is the minimum expectation and will not keep a student on pace for completion

RHO Attendance

- Fully online student's attendance is based on weekly communication. If students fail to respond to the teacher's communication attempts, the student will be considered absent for that week (per state attendance guidance).
- Students who do not meet the communication progress expectations:
 - After 1 week, the student will be put on probation
 - After 2 weeks, will remain on probation and be referred to the principal. Attendance contract will be put in place
 - After 3 weeks: The student's Graduation Alliance account will be paused, mandatory meeting with the principal, student, and parent. The attendance contract will be revisited
 - After 4 weeks: Students will be unenrolled

Pacing and Working Ahead

- Pacing in Graduation Alliance is designed to ensure students will complete the courses in a reasonable amount of time and finish all 6 courses by semester.
- Students may work ahead, BUT, new courses cannot be opened until the 6-week mark. This is due to enrollment rules that students must be enrolled and continue to show progress all semester in order to be full-time students.
