



COVID PROTOCOLS

KCHD Health Order: January 12, 2022

**Student/Staff has tested
POSITIVE for COVID**



ISOLATION REQUIRED:

Yes (Regardless of vaccination status)

ISOLATION TIME (AT HOME):

Ten (10) days after the onset of symptoms or date of a positive test (whichever is first).

Per KCHD public health order (1/11/22). This is true for all Kent County districts that do not have a universal face mask policy.

**QUARANTINE IS NOT REQUIRED, BUT THE
STUDENT OR STAFF MEMBER :**

Must wear a well-fitting mask through the duration of the household member's isolation +10 additional days while on campus.

*A person who has tested positive for COVID-19 in the last 90 days does not need to quarantine.

NO



QUARANTINE IS REQUIRED AND STUDENT OR STAFF MEMBER:

Must quarantine during the household member's full isolation period of at least five (5) days and for a minimum of five (5) days following the end of the isolation period.

UPON RETURNING TO SCHOOL:

The student or staff member must wear a well-fitting mask for an additional five (5) days, or continue to quarantine at home for five (5) additional days.

**Student is a Close
Contact at School**



CDC RECOMMENDATION:

If unvaccinated it is recommended to quarantine for five (5) days from the last date of known exposure.
