It is an exciting time of the year in the work of Cedar Springs Public Schools. While we remain focused on the current school year, we have started looking ahead at planning for 2023-2024. Counselors and students at the high school and middle school will soon be scheduling classes for next year. We have several positions posted and will begin interviewing shortly. We are getting a

head start on our hiring process to find the best people to support our students, families and staff next year. Lastly, we are preparing for several facility changes due to construction and reconfiguration.
